Drop off and Pick up Procedures 2023

General Information: Parents will arrive in their scheduled window for drop off and pick up. They will stay in the car and follow the staff directions/signs to drive through each station. If a camper is having a difficult time, they can pull up by the gym and park. A staff member will come to assist.

Medication Drop Off: Parents will drive through each station even if they do not have medications to drop off. The nurse will collect all medications in a ziplock bag with the printed (at home) medication form inside. **Prescription labels must match the instructions for administering all medications or have a note from a doctor.**

Mail Drop Off: If you would like to drop off Mail for your camper we will collect mail at the Medication drop. If you want to Mail Letters please allow 2-3 days for delivery. Mail Letters to Camp Tapawingo: P.O. Box 189, Falls City, OR 97344.

Food Drop Off: If a camper will not eat a planned meal or snack, you can send a replacement that can be heated up or handed to them at the time of that meal or snack.

Campers Drop Off: Counselors from the campers cabin will be waiting to help them carry their things and walk them to their cabin. This is a good time to quickly communicate any last minute needs to a person who will be working with the camper. You can also hand them a note or letter if there are any updates that we need to know.
